Dear Tom,

At the last V.A.V.A. Executive meeting, a report was presented on the initial meeting to plan the Sports Expo '80 exhibition.

The Victorian Olymoic Council have involved themselves in next years Expo, and already, a more proffessional planning approach is evident. The Expo is planned to run from Friday 15th February to Sunday 24th February inclusive. An Olympic Village is planned within the exhibition, and Volleyball has been chosen as one of the 'selected few' to be involved in this section.

Tentative times have already been set for displays by each sport in the Olympic arena and Volleyball has fared very well with its time slot allocation. In addition, four televised periods have been allocated, varying from 40 mins. to 45 mins.

The V.A.V.A. is planning a similar display to last years Expo, but on a more professional basis. This will involve manning the display continuously giving away hand outs, showing films and supervising the 'try out' area. At the appointed times, matches will be staged, with the best matches being selected for the T.V. coverage.

The purpose of my letter is to enquire of the V.C.V.C. about any assistance in any form they may be able to provide, be it personel for setting-up/dismantling, manning the display or providing teams for matches. Attached is a copy of the schedule for your information. This schedule is only tentative at this stage. We would appreciate your thoughts and suggestions in the near future.
