The V.A.V.A. have received official notification of the grants under the 1979/80 Sports Assistance program.

Of the total of \$14200, \$200 has been allocated to 'Play Again' programmes. We invite the V.C.V.C.'s thoughts in the form of a submission for the application of this grant.

The 'Play Again' program is designed at encouraging past participants, particularly in the older age groups, to take up the sport again. In our submission, we proposed a form of Veterans Championships, aimed initially at the Metropolitan area. The initial enthusiasm in the Melbourne area is now not so evident, so the V.C.V.C. are invited to give consideration to such an event in the country areas, or even covering the whole State.

The whole of the \$200 could be made available if a suitable proposal is presented. I would appreciate your response before Friday 2nd November to enable the allocation of the grants to be made at the November Executive Council meeting.
