This letter represents the views of the Latrobe Valley's representative players and coaches who recently took part in the V.C.V.C. U17 Championships at Wangarratta. It's also the view of the L.V.V.A. Executive Committee after hearing evidence from it's representatives.


The members of the winning teams received, apart from the Perpetual Shield a pair of socks each. This, we think would be a fairly decent trophy if it had been an Invitation Tournament, but the fact remains that it was the Country Championships and surely gold or silver medallions are the order of the day for the winning team members.

Do the trophies come under V.C.V.C. jurisdiction? We think they should seeing that it is a V.C.V.C. Championship. Any V.C.V.C. Championship, whether it be Open, Under 20, or Under 17 is the prestige tournament of the year for the players concerned from all our member Associations, and to receive the gold medal at one of the championships is the ultimate in a country player's ambitions within the V.C.V.C.

We strongly urge the V.C.V.C. to investigate this matter, and if the trophies for all V.C.V.C. Championships do not come under V.C.V.C. jurisdiction, then can this oversight be included to the V.C.V.C.'s list of responsibilities in the future?

We ask this so that the status of these championships doesn't relegate into an U17 Tournament, but remains as the prestige event for all U17 players in Victoria.
