## V.A.V.A. PLANNING MEETING

Several major decisions are facing the V.A.V.A. Executive, the main one being the appointment of a full time Executive Officer. This possible appointment has some wide ramifications, especially in the financing of the appointment and the Executive would appreciate your thoughts and directions on these matters.

Accordingly, I invite two representatives of your Association or Commission, and each EXM V.A.V.A. Executive member, to attend this planning seminar, which is set down for Saturday 10th May, commencing at 10 am at the Youth, Sport and Recreation Secretariat, Olympic Park Administration offices, Swan Street, Melbourne.

In order that the maximum benefit be obtained from this meeting, I would ask you to come prepared with a list of problems your Association or Commission faces, no matter how large or small, and a list of items which you would like the V.A.V.A. to undertake on your behalf. We will not be able to formulate a path for the future unless these items are identified.

I would propose that an initial period be set aside for identification of the points mentioned above, and then the meeting may be split into groups to discuss the ways and means of achieving the aims. The meeting can then be rounded off by hearing a short report from each group, and making some recommendations on the best way to achieve the aims listed.

I urge each and every Association to be represented, as this will be your opportunity to really contribute and be heard.
