Subject: REVISED PERSONAL ACCIDENT COVER UNDER VOLLEYPACK

The Volley Pack Insurance Brokers have offered a revised cover for personal accident insurance. You should be aware, that the personal accident cover, under Section 3 of the Volley Pack brochure provided cover in units of \$5,000 for capital sums and \$90 per week compensation. For example if 3 units were taken, providing a \$15,000 capital cover with \$90. per week compensation, the premium would be \$32.40 per annum. This cover was limited to weekly compensation for up to 52 weeks, and for accidents arising whilst playing volleyball only.

The revised offer covers members whilst playing volleyball and whilst travelling to and from the premises where they play.

The scope of cover is \$5,000 for death by accident, \$500 medical expenses, over and above any recovery from a Health Fund, and weekly benefits of \$100.. The premium for benefits up to 52 weeks is \$21.40 per annum. If the weekly benefits is limited to 26 weeks, the premium would be \$12.84. This is a substantial reduction on the cover proposed in the original brochure, and may be of interest to your members.
