The Championships will be presented in Melbourne in August this year and already ten countries have signified their intention to take part. They are:—

China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Kuwait, Malaysia,
 New Zealand, Pakistan and Phillipines.

These Championships will be recognised as the Asian Confederation Qualifying Tournament for the 1976 Olympic Games in Montreal.

Monash University will be available from August 16th to 30th to accommodate all teams and officials and it provides excellent facilities.

Bed and breakfast will be provided at approx. \$8 per day and full board is also available.

Three playing venues are reserved and the tentative match program is as follows:
