## International Volleyball Coaches Course

---

The Australian Volleyball Federation (Inc.) is proud to announce the staging of the first International Coaches Course in Australia, 4th to the 18th December, 1978. Details are as follows:

- 1. Category of Course**  
Both the International Course 1 (basic) and the International Course 2 (advanced) will be conducted.
- 2. Language**  
The official language will be English.
- 3. Dates**  
4/12/78 to 18/12/78 (both Courses simultaneously). Opening Ceremony 10.00 a.m. on Monday, 4th December, 1978.
- 4. Venue**  
The course will be held at:

- 5. Lecturers (Tentative)**  
Mr. Horst Baacke (I.V.B.F. Coaches Commission).

- 6. Course Fee**  
**Participants** \$200.00 (Aust.)  
(Included in this is the text-book, notes, folder, pen, exam, I.V.B.F. registration fee, facility hire, equipment hire, T-shirt, badge, administration fee etc.).  
**Observers** \$50.00 (Aust.)  
(This includes administration fee, t-shirt, badge and text-book).  
Fees to be reduced if Government grants received.
- 7. Examinations**  
The courses conclude with theoretical and practical examinations and successful candidates receive the Certificate of the International Coaches Commission. This course is both physically and mentally demanding.
- 8. Numbers**  
There is a limit of 40 placed on participants. These will be chosen on merit. Any number of observers who do not become formally qualified may attend at a cost of \$50.00
- 9. Course Content**  
I.C.1 includes about 26 practicals and 28 the sessions, covering topics such as mini-volleyball, theory of training, physical preparation basics, systems, team formation, health etc.  
I.C.2 includes about 18 practicals and 42 the sessions, covering topics such as theoretical bases, methods of training, combinatoric statistics, strategy and tactics of coach psychology etc.
