Where possible the following details are given for each article:

- 1) Title, volume, part, number and date of periodical.
- 2) The article number (left side of article).
- 3) Title of article, translated into English where necessary.
- 4) Author (s).
- 5) Number of pages involved (right side of article).

The periodicals which are held at the Department for Youth, Sport and Recreation may be available for consultation between 9.30 – 12.30, Monday to Friday.

PHOTOCOPY REQUESTS

Photocopies of articles from periodicals held in the library may be supplied according to the provisions of the Copyright Act (1968-1976).

The Copyright Act, Section 40 states –

"A fair dealing with a literary, dramatic, musical or artistic work or with an adaptation of a literary, dramatic or musical work for the purpose of research or private study does not constitute an infringement of the copyright in the work".

Literary institutions define a fair dealing as photocopying of one article in a single periodical or journal for research or private study.
