Now is the time to plan for that team to ensure that Australia is not disgraced.

The Victorian Amateur Volleyball Association is going to do its part by ensuring that players are given as much international competition as possible. It has already employed an International Coach full time to help achieve its aims.

Ten Thousand Dollars is needed each year to make the dream a reality.

A Trust Fund is being established of \$100,000.00, made up of units of \$1000.00 each.

The Fund will be administered through a Solicitor's Trust Account and invested on First Mortgage Securities.

On current expectations this should produce in excess of \$12,000.00 per annum.

The Units are redeemable on giving at least three months notice in writing to the Secretary of the Victorian Amateur Volleyball Association.

Repayment will be made on the next interest date after the three months notice expires.

The Trust Fund is initially for the period up to and including the 1988 Olympics but will continue thereafter subject to review.
