Dear Sir,

As some States have objected to the V.A.V.A. decision to make an entry charge for all officials and players at the coming Under 20 Championships, my Executive has asked me to set out the reasons for this.

The staging of championships is always costly and unfortunately Victoria is obliged to stage two National Titles in this financial year and is only able to receive one State Government Grant.

Also you will all realise the problem of controlling entry of spectators and the difficulty of distinguishing friends and spectators from players and officials which in effect means that out takings never reflect the real spectator attendance.

My committee will be charging \$1 per day for the five days to spectators and will be issuing all officials and players with a souvenir badge for entry at all times plus a free program, and feels that the charge of \$4 is not unreasonable in all the circumstances.

We do not wish to create a precedent but we do have a heavy financial commitment for Australian Championships in this particular financial year, and therefore confidently ask for your support at this time.
