MINUTES

Coaching Committee Meeting, 5 Malonga Court
North Caulfield 27/8/77

Present: Mrs R. Micic, Messrs R. Kenter, D. Watson,
W. Gollong, Tomas Santamaria, E. Hayman.

Mr Hayman reported that workers compensation insurance cover had been taken out, premium \$537.45, and also a personal accident policy which would provide \$2000 cover for death or certain injuries, and full salary while disabled, and would cover most occurrences not otherwise covered by workers compensation.

A public liability policy for \$100,000 would cost \$48.15 and it was suggested that V.A.V.A. take this insurance as it would cover all activities as well as coaching.

Mr Santamaria had been measured for an official blazer and a pocket was being prepared. He had also taken a vehicle provided by Mr Hayman on loan and an account for petrol and service had been opened for his use at the B.F. Service Station at Keilor Park.

Mr Kenter tabled a circular sent to all Country Associations and advised that the C.V.C. would be meeting in Melbourne on October 1st and 2nd.

He also provided a list of officials and addresses to be copied and circulated.

Mr Gollong advised he would be willing to miss the A.V.F. Executive Meeting in Hobart so that Mr Santamaria could go and meet with the Australian teams and officials, and this offer was accepted with appreciation.

Mr Gollong also reported that the Department of Youth, Sport and Recreation required all sports involved to submit a three-year coaching plan by the end of December next and that he would assist the Committee with this. He would also immediately submit a claim for progress payment of the Department grant.

Mr Santamaria provided a copy of the latest rule book and Mr Gollong agreed to check this with our copies and see that books were available as required.

Mr Watson would check the Ballarat and Bendigo programmes involving Mr Santamaria and advise as soon as possible.

Mrs Micic had contacted the Education Department and suggested we write to Mr T. Mann offering a two-day seminar to the Physical Education staff.

Mr Watson suggested concentrating our first efforts on schools already active. Mr Gollong would contact Mt Scopus, Glen Waverley High, Croydon High and a Catholic college.

He would also write from V.A.V.A. to School Councils offering coaching services, not nominating any fee but suggesting that a donation would be welcome.

Mr Santamaria said he would like the opportunity to coach a team of his own in whatever spare time was available and Mr Watson and Mr Gollong agreed to assist him in finding a suitable venue.

The promotion of Mini Volleyball was discussed at some length and it was agreed that Mr Santamaria would advance its development wherever possible.

Mr Gollong would arrange for Mr Santamaria to conduct a referees' course for the Eastern Association on three Thursday evenings as soon as possible.

Mr Santamaria would complete a tax form claiming for his four sons and would be paid by cheque.
