## V.A.V.A. - Budget 1977:

The proposed budget was submitted to the  
assembly for discussion and all income and expense  
items were explained and commented on.

## Business arising -

- 1.) M.V.C. President stated that the M.V.C. would put forward \$ 2000 towards the appointment of a State Director of Coaching for one year only.
- 2.) Possibility that a Korean team being brought out to Australia - Sydney, Melbourne and Adelaide - W. Lebedew working at it. Funds will be required.
- 3.) Social Committee - Mr. N. Fisher.
  - a.) T-shirts to be produced for the purpose of fund raising.
  - b.) Proposal to hold two social nights per annum - June '77 and Nov. '77 - suitable localities to be investigated.
  - c.) Wine bottling with V.A.V.A. label to be investigated.
  - d.) Fund raising to be conducted throughout the year.

- e.) All monies to go into a common travel fund.
- 4.) Mr. Mraz - Suggestion that the State Travel Fund to be used solely to subsidise players and officials at National Championships.  
Suggestion that a certain percentage of the registration fees be allocated for the same purpose.
- 5.) Mr. Fricsons - All spectator entrance monies on Sundays to be collected by the State Squad Members - Adults \$ 0.50 and Juniors \$ 0.20 - throughout the year. This money to be paid into the State Travel Fund.
- 6.) MOTION -  
That V.A.V.A. allocates the sum of \$ 1750 as subsidy for the National Championships at Perth and to be divided equally between the men's and women's team. Individual players to receive equal proportional amounts.
