9.) GENERAL BUSINESS

a.) Report on Oceania Championships - N.Z.

Mr. J. Hiller gave a verbal report. Organization of very high standard - suggests a letter from A.V.F. be sent conveying congratulations on organization. Stadium more than adequate with reasonable crowds. Communication between officials and players extremely good. Accommodation basic but comfortable. The Australian men performed extremely well executing many combinations and plays.

Both Men and Women improved their standard of play after First Asian Games in August.

b.) Report on Asian Volleyball Conference in Japan by Mr. E. Hayman.

The feeling is that Australia should be involved in the Central Zone for greater competition. The Asian Junior Games have been left to Australia to organize. The next Asian Regional Tournament will be held in Hong Kong from 15th - 29th November 1976. This will be an elimination competition for the World Cup in Japan in 1977. Australia proposed to send both Mens' and Womens' teams.

Mr. Thomas A. Santamaria has nominated himself by invitation as coach within Victoria. V.A.V.A. Executive most impressed with his qualifications.
