In reply ~~to~~ your letter of 19th September, concerning the Egg Industry Stabilisation Legislation, I wish to inform you that our Executive has met and discussed your letter and we are very disappointed at your attitude towards the continuation of the Egg Stabilisation Act Legislation for an indefinite period most especially after the meeting held with you and all sections of the Egg Industry on 21st August, voted unanimously "that the Egg Industry Stabilization Act legislation should continue indefinitely after 1st March, 1980, without significant alteration".

Our Association supports the original submission from the Victorian Egg Industry, and we request that representatives of the Industry meeting meet the Agricultural Committee of the Parliamentary Liberal Party to put their case.
