Minutes of Executive Meeting held at Co-op, Stanley Street,
Bendigo on Friday 28th March, 1980.

R. Robins opened the meeting and welcomed 6 members present.

REPORT - A. Hudson reported on F.C.P.F.A. meeting, the significant thing being that Ted Chapman, Minister of Agriculture in S.A., opened the Conference.

Meatmeal - agreed that Poultry Advisory Committee in each State, doing the best they can. Stock Feed Wheat - Minister had something to do with the amending of legislation in that State, he stated that Organisations can make representations through the State Government to the Commonwealth Government on Stock Feed Wheat. A submission had been made to the Government by V.F.G.A. on retaining the price for 6 months.

Price of Quota - W.A. \$16 if available, S.A. \$8 - \$10,

N.S.W. \$12 - \$13, Qld. \$3. - \$3.25 (just commencing)

All States will support Victoria in the Inquiry into Egg Industry, All Boards are expected to make personal representation at the Inquiry.

National Farmers Federation - discussion as to whether the N.F.F. could change its affiliation to let smaller organisations join, all present were in agreement.

Animal liberation - C.E.M.A. to prepare a film showing the set up of modern poultry farming in Australia, World Poultry Science Organisation to look after this problem.

Discussion on Egg Marketing Enquiry.

Decided to apply for oral submission (deputation) on behalf of our Association.

Decided to submit copy of draft of combined industry meeting held on 5th October, 1979, as support for the continuation of the Egg Stabilization Scheme.

Secretary to ring other Branches for their support, either written or oral.
