Dear Mr, Whiting,

I am writing on behalf of the Commercial Egg Producers' Association of Victoria to support your stand against the extension of daylight saving in Victoria.

Our Association comprises 800 members, we are unanimous against any extension of the time of daylight saving and about 98% in favour of abandoning it altogether. We believe it is not suitable for country people because firstly on its effect of primary production including dairyfarmers and all harvesting work. It is also difficult for parents sending small children on school buses.

We suggest that a gallop poll be taken in country areas, this would prove that daylight saving is not suitable.
