STATUTORY DECLARATION



1. THAT I am the General Secretary of The Australian Workers' Union (Hereinafter referred to as "the Association").
2. THAT I am the proper Officer of The Association authorised to make this declaration on its behalf.
3. THAT the Association is an association of employees and desires to be recognised as an association of employees under the Industrial Relations Act 1979 (Victoria).
4. THAT the application for recognition as an association of employees is made in accordance with the Rules of the Association and has been executed in accordance with the Rules of the Association.
5.
