I would be pleased if you could give the following your consideration before attending our Conference at the City Hall, Bendigo on Friday next 3rd December, 1982:-

- (1) The intended legislation re hen licensing and quotas.
- (2) The problem of transferring of quotas still occurring, rumors of farms being supposedly sold (we need farms to continue operating in the district to maintain our local grading floor.)
- (3) The concern of imported wheat being available only to the feed mills, and the suggestion that local stocks of grain be reserved for pig and poultry home mixers.
- (4) Interstate eggs being used by Victorian Government Department (Railways) and local pie maker (Gillies).
- (5) Whether it be possible for more eggs to be used by prisons and retention centres.

Hoping you can have some information on the above matters for us.
