Dear John,

On behalf of our Association I have been requested to bring to your attention the following issues which affect our members:-

(1) We are concerned about the importing of wheat which we believe can only be put through the feed mills. We see a danger of present local stocks of grain running out and would suggest that this wheat be reserved for the use of poultry and pig home feed mixers.

(2) From what we read there seems to be an abundance of corn in America and talks of it being ploughed back into the ground, could your Government have a look at the possibility of importing some of this corn.

(3) Our Association is concerned re the exporting of meatmeal; at this stage because of drought and future low killing of stock in Australia, we believe it's time to look into this matter.

We are holding our half yearly conference on December 3rd, I would be grateful if you could inform me re these matters before then.
