Dear Alan:

At a meeting of the Board and Producer Organisations in February this year where the subject of Brown Eggs was discussed, all organisations represented at that meeting were against the introduction of Brown Eggs onto the market.

We feel that there is enough variation in grades on the market at the present time, an added one will only cause more confusion. The premium on this grade would, to the public, make eggs look more expensive and could act against us.

We agree with the Board's principle of meeting with producers to discuss future trends in the industry, but it does seem a waste of time, when the decision reached at such a meeting is not adhered to.

Our Association hopes that the Board will have another look at the matter of Brown Eggs and change their proposed policy.
