
Dear ~~Miss~~^R Broadbent,

In response to representations I have made on your behalf to the Minister for Industry and Commerce, the Minister has advised me that whilst the Government does not intend at this stage to vary its program in regard to diesel rebate, his department will nevertheless be monitoring very carefully the problems that will arise as a result of this decision.

In this sense, the Minister has pointed out that the Government will be prepared to consider a review of the excise arrangements if such a decision is required after an assessment of the overall operations.

I regret I have not been able to assist you further in this matter at this stage.
