Dear Mr. Broadbent,

Further to my letter of 18th January 1983 regarding consignment fees, I understand that the Crystal Egg Co. group grade works as follows :

1. Class "A" consignments under 12 cases normally go into the Class "A" group grade but the Producer may request an individual grade and if so will be charged a consignment fee. (This is worked out with the Producer when the group grade first started and whatever arrangements were agreed at that time, have continued unless the Producer has requested a change.)
2. Washed eggs (Class "B") sent in by Class "A" Producers, normally go into the Class "B" group grade if under 12 cases but again the Producer may request an individual grade and if so will be charged a consignment fee.

The exception to these procedures is, of course, that a Producer may not pre-sort or pre-select second quality or useless eggs as a consignment for the group grade pool. This has occurred in some instances and a separate certificate has been prepared and a separate consignment fee charged.

The group grade pool price is regularly adjusted so that the total paid to all consignees in the pool is the value of the eggs in the pool and the grading floor neither gains or loses in the operation of the pool.
