and include three commercial egg producers (Messrs Bell, Hohl and Schofield). Other members hold senior positions in government or industry.

This rare opportunity will provide producers with the chance to acquaint themselves with current research priority areas. It will also give them the opportunity to air their views on research priorities and problems. This is the first time the Council has approached producers in this way anywhere.

Almost \$700,000 will be spent on research into the egg industry during 1987-88. Half this money comes from you, the producer, and half from the Federal Government. Therefore, you are invited to meet the Council and have your say.

As far as the evening is concerned it is proposed that a member of Council briefly address those in attendance. A formal question and answer session will then follow, followed by the chance for one-on-one discussion. In co-operation with VEMB staff the Council will provide coffee and sandwiches to those in attendance.
