"At our recent monthly combined C.E.P.A. meeting, a large number of producers unanimously decided that the meeting held with you was not as beneficial as you claimed in your summary. The actual crux of the meeting, that should have been spelt out, is that if Crystal doesn't absorb more costs and reduce its profit margin, as producers have had to, then there won't be any eggs to grade. The meeting decided that Bendigo producers should be, at least, on the same level as those that use Keysborough, as it is becoming more attractive with each dockage increase."
