Very soon the Government will be deciding what to do with the Public Bodies Review Committee Report into the Egg Industry.

Tell your local MP that:

* You want eggs to remain Vested in the Victorian Egg Board

WHY? So the Board can remain effective against the might of the supermarket monopolies.

* You do NOT want hen quotas to be phased out.

WHY? So the egg industry can produce the correct number of eggs for the local market and not produce a wasteful surplus.

* You want the maximum farm size to be raised to 100,000 hens.

WHY? So the industry can achieve economies of scale in the future.

* You want the number of hens allowed to be kept without quota to remain at 20 and NOT increased to 500 as proposed.

WHY? The numbers of backyard hens will increase and commercial producers will be forced to take quota cuts.

* The price of eggs as set by the Prices Commissioner is too low and you are going broke.

WHY? Because the Commissioner is a consumer advocate who does not fully understand our industry. His report contains many errors.

* You want egg prices to be set by the Victorian Egg Board.

WHY? Because the Prices Commissioner cannot respond to the day to day requirements of the market place, whereas the Board can.

* Whatever happens, you do NOT want one person alone to have power over egg prices.

WHY? Because your livelihood is at the mercy of one person's opinions, which may be unreasonable and one sided.
