TO: ALL PRODUCERS AND GRADING FLOORS
RE: CHANGE TO BOARD SHELL EGG BUYING PRICE
(EFFECTIVE, MONDAY, 24TH DECEMBER, 1990.)

Due to the continuing over-supply of 49 gram and 43 gram eggs, the Board's shell egg purchase price will be reduced for these two grades with effect from Monday, 24th December, 1990.

| <u>Grade</u> | <u>Previous Purchase Price - ¢/dozen</u> | <u>Price Effective 24/12/1990</u> | <u>Change</u> |
|--------------|--|-----------------------------------|---------------|
| 49 gram | 90 | 80 | -10¢ |
| 43 gram | 80 | 73 | -7¢ |

The above prices are for shell eggs delivered to Keysborough and do not include any packing material value.

The Board's purchase price of shell egg for the other three grades remains unchanged:

Farm Pride Products have also advised that from 24th December, 1990, its buying price for product eggs in shell will be reduced from \$1.40/Kg. to \$1.30/Kg. Consequently producers supplying ungraded eggs to Keysborough will be paid the equivalent rate per dozen for that percentage of their delivery which is paid at Product prices.

**RE: FURTHER PAYMENT FOR PRODUCT EGGS
PURCHASED UNDER CONTRACT**

The Board has now reviewed the trading position for egg products for the year ended 30 June, 1990. The Board had previously announced a second payment of 10 cents per kg for product eggs covering the period 28 August, 1989 to 9 March, 1990 based on the trading results at that stage. This final review confirmed the profitability of the Egg Products Trading operation for the full year and a second payment of 10 cents per kg will now be made on all product eggs and farm pulp brought under contract in the period 10 March, 1990 to 30 June, 1990.

Producers who have Product Supply Contracts covering the period 10 March, 1990 to 30 June, 1990 will receive their second payment this week.

TO: ALL PRODUCERS
SUBJECT: SEASONAL QUOTA RESTRICTION

As explained in Circular No.13 the Committee is keeping a very close watch on the Egg surplus situation. This Circular is to bring producers up to date with the latest thinking on any further seasonal cut.

Present Position

Shell egg sales are still quite strong and the Victorian Egg Marketing Board advises that it still requires eggs for egg product manufacture.

The production forecast from the Committee's Consultant indicates a possible total egg surplus between October and February.

Possible Seasonal Restriction


The Committee will review the egg supply position on October 1st.

If a further seasonal quota restriction is required at that time producers will be notified immediately.

If a restriction is announced it is expected to be in the range of 6% to 10% and would operate from October 29th.

Producers are reminded that a definite decision has not been made at this stage. The information is however an indication of the best forecasts currently available to the Committee.
