My wife and I thank you most sincerely for the generous reception you gave us on our recent visit to Fortuna. I myself was delighted to see the building, and particularly so, as I had missed out on two previous occasions, when visiting Bendigo.

Having noted the bearing and attitude of your staff, I came away happy that Fortuna is in good and caring hands.

I am enclosing names and addresses of two people who might be referred to for clarification of information. Stewart Hall would be well versed in family history; and though he now lives in Adelaide, has lived most of his life in Bendigo, and has acted as executor for family estates, etc. Mrs Jenkins is a daughter of Tom Lansell, and could perhaps have more information re George Lansell's branch of the family.

I enclose photostat of Wootton's marriage certificate - mainly to confirm the spelling of his name.

His maritime certificate of service may be of interest, as background information. I held the original until about twenty years ago, when it became obvious that the paper was getting brittle and fragile. The John Oxley Library staff agreed to hold it in a neutral atmosphere, and it is still in their care. The photostat I obtained from them is not of really good quality, and perhaps a better one could now be obtained if desired.
