Referring to the letter from the Secretary to the Premier dated the 15th. inst. regarding Christmas relief work scheme, I beg to inform you that the Council is pleased to accept under the conditions outlined in the above circular the allocation of £1500 which has been made available to this Municipality for relief work to be carried out prior to Christmas for registered unemployed persons.

I submit herewith schedule of works in accordance with the circular letter from the Premier's Office. The Council is supplementing the Department's grant by £574. It is proposed to put on 200 men comprised of laborers, painters, carpenters, concretors, every five days to be engaged on the following works which are of a permanent nature and would not be works within the current municipal year's program -
