Dear Sir/

I desire, on behalf of the Bendigo Sewerage Authority, which consists of the Bendigo City Council, to apply for permission for men to be allowed to work for sustenance at the Sewerage Farm, Epsom.

This property is situated about 5 miles from the Bendigo Post Office and, if the application is granted, motor bus transport to and from the work to the Bendigo Post Office will be provided. The work upon which it is desired that the men shall be employed is as follows:-

Cleaning out existing channels and drains, and cutting new channels and drains where those existing are abandoned.

Levelling off mine dumps at old gold workings and grading uneven land.

Thinning out timber and eradicating rushes and noxious weeds in swamps on the creek frontages and elsewhere.

It is also desired to employ men at the Sanitary Depot, Wellsford, for grubbing and clearing of scrub lands, also cleaning up fire breaks along boundary fence line adjoining State Forest or reserves. The same condition with regard to transport would apply to this work.

The City Engineer will be able to make the men available for the work.
