Dear Sirs,

I have been instructed to bring before your notice a complaint which has been made by members of this Association who are working for sustenance.

The complaint lies with the insufficient sanitary arrangements on sustenance works. The men complain that where there are lavatories supplied they are far from suitable for the purpose and are detrimental to the workers' health. It is also complained that sanitary arrangements are not supplied on all jobs.

The members of this Association consider that it is very essential that correct sanitary arrangements should be supplied on all sustenance works.

We are hoping that this matter will be taken up immediately for the sake of the health of the workers concerned.
