ANOTHER VALLEY BOY KILLED.

On Saturday last Mrs. Boyce, of Tal-langatta Valley, was officially advised that her son, Private George Henry (Jim) Boyce, No. 112I, had died of gunshot wounds on 13th April, 1918, in the 1st Canadian Stationary Hospital. Private Boyce returned to his home in March, 1916, from Gallipoli, having been wounded, but after four months' rest he was ordered back to the front. His brother Thomas was killed about 12 months ago in France. Two other brothers, Frank and Eddie, are still on active service. Mrs. Boyce, who is a widow, will have the public's heartfelt sympathy in her increased burden of grief.
