PMHPS commentary on the various locations in the movie.



Aspect: Bay Street footpath looking north across Bridge Street to the Bay Stores Licensed Grocers. The Fountain Inn is in view at the top right of the photo.



Aspect: Bay Street looking north with the Port Melbourne Town Hall on the left.



Aspect: Bay Street looking south from the east side. The street with the pedestrian is Pool Street and the bus is about to cross Bridge Street.



Aspect: Vehicle & pedestrian ferry travelling from Newport to Port Melbourne. The old Newport Power Station is in the background.



Aspect: Garden City Port Melbourne. This photo may have been taken (a) from Garden City Reserve looking at Tucker Street or (b) from Garden City Reserve looking at Beacon Road.



Aspect: Garden City, Port Melbourne. Most likely a photo of Crichton Avenue taken from near the corner of Poolman Street looking north towards Graham Street.



Aspect: The Eclipse Theatre shortly before the commencement of demolition. The Eclipse was located on the south east corner of Crockford & Pickles Streets, Port Melbourne.



Aspect: North east corner of Williamstown Road and Southward Avenue, Port Melbourne.



Aspect: The Princess of Tasmania ferry terminal was located at Webb Dock at the south western end of Williamstown Road just past Todd Road.



Aspect: Train departing the Port Melbourne Station. The train carriages in the photo appear to be of the type which open out (rather than slide), these were known at the time as Box Cars (those with the sliding doors were known as the Red Rattlers), both versions are Tait designed trains.



Aspect: Administrative headquarters of General Motors Holden located on the west side of Salmon Street opposite the Turner Street intersection.



Aspect: Kraft manufacturing plant located on the block bounded by Salmon Street, Turner Street, Douglas Street and Cook Street.



Aspect: In the movie the camera pans from (the above photo) the “Quartettes” social housing at 444-472 Williamstown Road across the road to the Wormald premises at 455-475 Williamstown Road, Port Melbourne.



Aspect: View south from the peak of Centenary Bridge, Port Melbourne.



Aspect: Location unknown. Likely to have been taken from the western end of Williamstown Road looking over the wetlands, the background includes the refinery and associated buildings in Williamstown.



Aspect: Balm Paints Pty Ltd (later renamed Dulux) situated on the north west corner of Williamstown Road and Salmon Street, Port Melbourne.



Aspect: Unknown. It may be a view of Lorimer Street looking east from near the corner of Salmon Street.



Aspect: View of the housing along the south side of Williamstown Road, looking east from the corner of Salmon Street.



Aspect: View from the north west corner of Bridge Street and Williamstown Road looking east towards Ingles Street. The twin chimneys of the Dunlop Tyre factory are in the background.



Aspect: View of the southern section of the King Street bridge, South Melbourne prior to its opening.
