

# **COCKATOO COMMUNITY COMPLEX**

In 1976, recognising that Cockatoo was the second largest Township within the Shire, and acknowledging requests by the community for the provision of recreation facilities, Council purchased some four hectares of land strategically located in the Town Centre and, in conjunction with the local community, embarked upon a programme of staged development of the site.

The first stage saw the construction of the Kindergarten building which was opened on the 22nd November, 1977, following which the bowling green, tennis courts, netball courts and public toilets were developed.

The community building represents the final stage of development of the site, and it is coincidental that the opening of this building is taking place almost exactly five years to the day from the opening of the Kindergarten, which was the first stage. By careful planning in respect of design, materials, finish and fittings, costs have been kept to a level much lower than for similar buildings of a comparable size, whilst at the same time resulting in a facility that is suitable for multi-use and blends in with the overall development of the Complex.

The anticipated final cost of the building is in the order of \$150,000, of which the local community will contribute \$33,000, the State Government \$50,000, and the Council \$67,000. Both Council and the Committee responsible for the development of the Complex recognised the need for a total joint co-operation, and it has been as a result of that partnership that the development of the Cockatoo Community Complex Reserve is now complete.
