WEIGHING OUT

RULE 156.—If a jockey or rider intend to carry overweight exceeding by more than two pounds in a flat race, or four pounds in a hurdle race or steeplechase, the weight at which his horse is to run, he must declare the amount of his overweight to the Clerk of Scales when being weighed out, and the Clerk shall exhibit such extra weight outside the weighing room.

RULE 159.—A jockey or rider shall mount the horse to be ridden by him in any race within such enclosure or place as the Stewards may appoint, and shall not without leave of the Stewards leave the jockey's room or such enclosure before mounting to proceed to the starting post.

THE JUDGE'S DECISION.
RULE 195.—The determination of a Judge declaring a horse to have won, or to be entitled to a place, shall be final unless an objection is made and allowed on the ground of disqualification. Provided that this rule shall not prevent a Judge from correcting any mistake before the placed horses are weighed in.

WIN AND PLACE RECKONER.

Table is based on bet of 10/- for win and 10/- for place (1, 2, 3) when 6 or more start. Last three columns apply when 2, 6, or 7 start. Minute fractions are omitted.

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NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC.

On all betting tickets the name of the horse and amount of bet must be clearly written. Should a dispute arise, and it be found that this has not been done, a decision may be given against the Bookmaker.

In the event of any infringement of the above Regulations, or in the case of any disputed Bets, it is requested that the Secretary be at once communicated with.
