Dear Sir:

Under separate cover are forwarded blueprint copies of the following drawings representing the design of a one ton drop hammer for the aircraft factory:

North American Drawings No. TE-100	Sheets 1 to 10 inc.
Commonwealth Aircraft Corp. Drawings	Nos. T. 1001, T. 1002 and T. 1003

The drawings are being sent to enable you to arrange for the manufacture of this tool in Australia. It should be noted that a few modifications have been incorporated in the blueprints to enable the substitution of British standard threads for the U.S.S. threads specified. The material of the drum has been changed to cast steel.

I am also forwarding under separate cover Vandyke copies of the North American drawings mentioned above, and the original tracings of our own drawings, T. 1001, T. 1002 and T. 1003, to enable you to have prints run off in Melbourne for the purposes of manufacture. In this connection, however, it should be noted that such blueprints should be altered to conform to those forwarded to you.

It is not anticipated that any difficulty will arise in regard to the manufacture of this drop hammer in Australia, and the price should be much less than the cost of purchasing the equipment in this country and transporting it to Australia. The cost of a similar hammer produced here was \$2,000 at works.
