Re: Australian License

Under the terms of this license, my company has sent to your factory the following engineers for training in the manufacture of the NA-16 airplane:

1. T. W. Air      He is a technical draftsman who it is desired shall check all drawings, data, engineering studies, material lists and all theoretical and documentary details.
2. E. J. Smith    He is a practical workshop engineer who, it is desired, shall study methods of production and particularly the construction of tools, jigs, fixtures, and soft metal die making.
3. S. M. Bruce    He is a practical workshop engineer who, it is desired, shall study workshop technique and methods of fabrication for the entire airplane.

As I am very shortly leaving for the east, I would like to place these men under your control and authority to work under such departments as you may decide is appropriate. Any communication in regard to them should be addressed to me direct while I am in U.S.A. or to the Company in Australia if I am not available.

It is proposed that they should spend from three to four months at the factory. Final instructions in this regard will be supplied later.
