Subject: Delivery of Broaches
T.R.Q.'s 96, 99 and 112.

We acknowledge receipt of your P.466 and confirm our cable in reply, as follows:-

"RE P466 REDUCE REQUIREMENT TO ONE SET BROACHES FOR LIGHT ALLOY BLADES RETAIN TWO SETS FOR STEEL. WE REQUIRE BROACHES FOR LIGHT ALLOY AND ONE SET FOR STEEL SUPPLIED PROGRESSIVELY IN BLADE SETS EX FRANCE PERIOD FEBRUARY TO MAY 63. REMAINING SETS FOR STEEL SOON AS POSSIBLE THEREAFTER. IN VIEW S.N.E.C.M.A. ORIGINAL TOOLING DELIVERY PROMISES PRESS STRONGLY FOR THESE DELIVERIES. LETTER FOLLOWS."

In view of the fact that there will be ample life in one set of the broaches for the light alloy blades, and to reduce the load on S.N.E.C.M.A.'s tool supply capacity, we have decided to reduce our requirement to one set. Two sets were called for originally to provide for breakage or damage, but this factor will be covered by local production, in the event of it being necessary.

We will adhere to two sets of the broaches for the steel blades, where wear and the possibility of damage is greater.

The delivery dates quoted above are those necessary to meet our programme and we must insist that S.N.E.C.M.A. make every effort to meet our requirements.

This is particularly so, in view of their tooling delivery promises, made to the first Mission - a delivery of nine months for the tooling for the complete engine was given.
