(On Sundays and Certified Public Holidays one penny additional will be charged on each fare.)

In order to obviate the second surcharge of one penny where a passenger travels over two or more sections involving a change of cars, transfer tickets will be issued with the ordinary ticket.

The full fare for the entire journey contemplated must be paid upon the first car, except in the case of the Elmont & Albert line, and the passenger's destination stated to the conductor.

Both tickets must be retained till the end of the journey, and must be produced to the conductor or ticket examiner on demand.

Round Trip through Melbourne & Suburbs by
Cable and Electric Tramway

Description of Route.

At the Melbourne Town Hall the St Kilda Beach (green) car is taken, and a commencement is made in a southerly direction along St Kilda Road, which is beautified with plantations, and is the main southern thoroughfare to the city. On the east the Alexandra Avenue and Gardens presents a very pict-uresque sight, and Government House stands out on the hill overlooking the city, opposite the Government House gates are the Victoria Barracks. Proceeding along St Kilda Road, the Commercial Road and High Street tram termini are passed on the east side, and the Albert Cricket Ground on the west, where all important Australian Tennis matches are decided.

A turn into Dwyer Street brings the tram into the St Kilda Esplanade, from ~~where~~ a fine view of Hobson's Bay is obtainable. At the further end of the Esplanade a change of cars is made to the Deepdene Electric Tram.

Should the passenger desire, a short promenade on the Esplanade will allow of the St Kilda Pier, Baths, Beach and Gardens, being seen, also the various places of amusement, including Luna Park and the Palais de Danse, which on a summer evening, present a scene of the liveliest animation.

The Deep dene ^{electric} tram which starts opposite Luna Park is then taken. This tram runs along St Kilda and Caulfield, passing several parks and gardens. On turning into Glenferrie Road, the Malvern Shopping Centre, is passed through, and at High Street the Malvern Town Hall which is on the east side, is passed. "Stonnington" State Government House, is a little north of Malvern Road, and from this point an extensive view of the Dandenong Ranges is obtained. Continuing the trip along Glenferrie-road, one of Hawthorn's busy streets is passed through, and the Town Hall at Burwood Road is seen on the east side. On ascending the next hill, from which a view of Melbourne is obtained, you arrive at the bottom Road changing point. Before continuing the journey, the Cremorne ~~Town~~ may be visited, which is noted for some fine monumental work.

The Victoria Bridge car, which runs along High-street and Barkers-road, Kew, is then taken. On arrival at the terminus a change is made to the Victoria Street Cable Car.

Proceeding to Melbourne from the Victoria Bridge by the Cable car (Red), the metropolitan Fire Brigade Station and several Hospitals which are situated on the Eastern Hill, are passed. A turn into Collins street brings the car to the Melbourne Town Hall.

Passengers may board cars at any point on the route, and travel in either direction back to starting point.
