Built 1913, by Meadowbank N.S.W. for  
Prahran + Malvern T. Trust as N° 76  
Painted Dark red & yellow, twin N°s on apron.  
Became M + M.T.B. "J" class 76 and painted  
brown & yellow.

Mileage (Melbourne) 437,009

Sold in May 1931, to Ballarat, <sup>parcelled 21-7-31</sup> arrived per rail.  
Painted Red & cream with side N° & car not  
altered until <sup>30</sup> left 1936 to standard type and  
painted dark green & cream.

Painted Mid Bustol green & Ivory 24-12-49

Car jumped track in Sturt St, in bound from  
Lydiard St Nth. 8<sup>th</sup> Feb, 1948.

First car on re opening of View Point line. Car was 3.50pm  
in bound. Service re opened 18-6-51. 1/2 hr service 4 to 6pm.

Apron at one end in smash with road vehicle  
1/3/55. Complete headlight from ex N° 23. gold tam.

Painted yellow, black zebra stripes last 1960.

Transferred to Bendigo, leaving Wandooce  
deft about 10 am on 4<sup>th</sup> October 1960.
