

N^o 23 4 wheel combination (TRUCK ORDER N^o 16416)

Built in 1909 by Duncan & Fraser for the Municipal Tramways Trust Adelaide as N^o 69.

In service in Adelaide on 30/10/1909.

Painted Chocolate & yellow & Twin N^o on aprons at first Adelaide Mileage 632,958

Sold Oct 1937 To S.E.C. Ballarat & arrived ^{on 9-12-37} per rail
Ran in Adelaide's colors & N^o for some time

Decorated with waxed paper for 1938 Floral festival (March 38). Then stored until Boxing Day 38 & used on City - Gardens run.

Minor alterations only and painted Dark green & cream in early 1939.

Used mainly on the Lydiard St Nth - Rubicon St and City - Sturt St West lines.

Not used much after 1948.

Wed 17-3-48 on Mt Pleasant - Gardens line. ^{16/5/50}_{24/5/50} } on View-Point Line

Painted gold bronze in December 1950, spade & pick on both aprons, ^{painted silver} 132 electric globes & other decorations in Jan 1951. In service on 16-3-51 & ran daily until 26-3-51. Then stored until 13-8-51

Last used on Monday 20-8-51 (Public Holiday)
Ex Depot 2.15pm via Rifon St. and City Hall at 2.40pm
N^o 23 & 26 both specials to Victoria St terminus

Last trip to depot via Rifon St at 4pm.
