Built in 1916 by Duncan & Fraser
Hawthorn Tramway Trust N°18.

Painted plain grey, later grey & red lining
Hawthorn Tramway Trust in gold on sides

In service at Hawthorn 6-4-1916

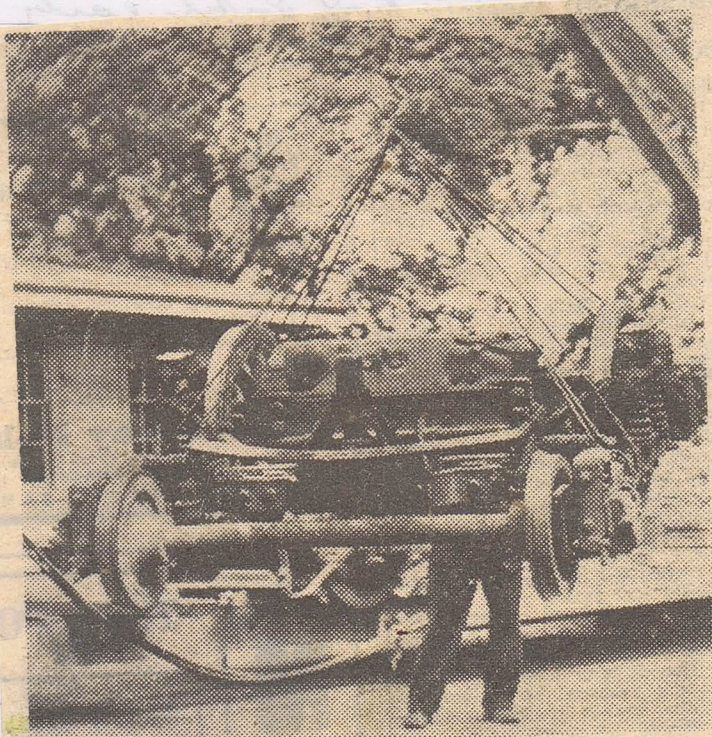
Became M & M-T-B "N" class N° 124, later
classed as "C" & painted brown & yellow, then
green & cream.

Sold to S.E.C. Ballarat Feb 1947, arrived at
Ballarat Fri afternoon 28-2-47

Altered & painted mid Bristol green & Ivory.
In service on Friday 13th June 1947.

Repainted Dec. 1955
