Woman, Child Hurt In Tram Mishap

A woman and a child received minor injuries when a tram was derailed in Wendouree parade yesterday afternoon.

The north-bound tram had just turned from Macarthur street into Wendouree parade, about 3 p.m., when the rear wheels left the lines.

The back section of the tram crashed into a pole at the side of the line and was considerably damaged.

Mrs Enid Kiel, of 8 Pryor street, Ballarat, and her three-year-old son, Peter, who were travelling in the rear compartment, were thrown from their seat, across the tram against the opposite seat.

They were taken to the Base Hospital, where they were de-

tained for observation, but were found to have no serious injuries.

Tramway men took one and a half hours to return the damaged tram to the lines, after which it was taken to the depot for repairs.

While this was being done, a shuttle service was operated on either side of the breakdown area, and little disruption was caused to services.
