**MONDAY TO FRIDAY.**

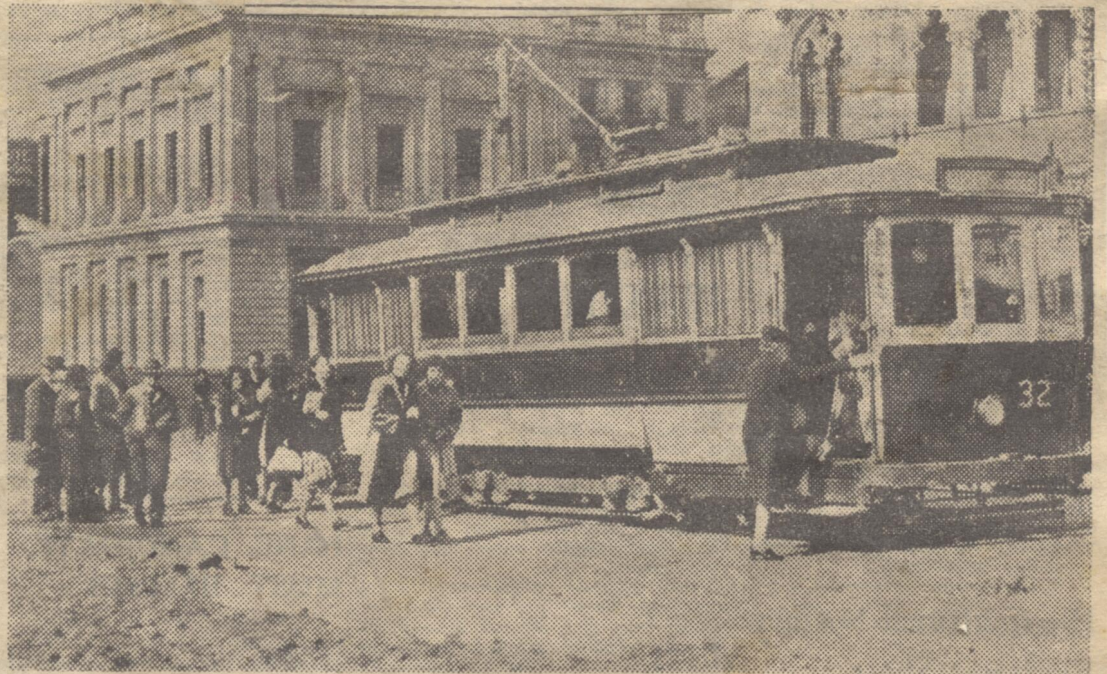
1. Between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m., a thirty-minute service only will operate on the following schedules (Minutes past the hour shown)—
