The electric Tramway System at Ballarat, Victoria is doomed to closure by the end of September, 1971.

This tramway is unique because it operates some types of tramcars withdrawn from service throughout Australia many years ago, and because of this, the system at present is an ideal operating museum.

However if the closure goes ahead the fantastic potential of this transport museum will be lost, unless part of it can be saved.

The Ballacrat Tramway Preservation Society has been formed with its aim to preserve and operate part of the system in its present form. The line proposed for retention is picturesquely situated on the shores of Lake Wendouree and is fortunate to have in its proximity a site for a new Depot which would have to be built. The line passes through the Ballarat Gardens, always a mecca for tourists; ensuring the museum of a continued existence and steady patronage.

If you join the Society then you will be helping preserve a tramway which in years to come will be as widely renowned as Puffing Billy for both its historic and tourist appeal.

The Society is administered by a Council of eleven Members elected from both Ballarat and Melbourne representitives. A subdivision of the Society is existent in Melbourne and conducts entertainment meetings at which films are shown and reports of the activities of the Society are discussed.
