 On display in protective enclosure at Vickers and Beverin Street:
 Sebastopol. Last car to operate under its own power in Ballarat streets when it was delivered to Sebastopol on 2/10/71.
 - Australian Electric Transport Museum, St. Kilda South Australia. 9/71. Part of the collection of our associated tramway museum. Car in same condition as at Ballarat, except trolley hook has been fitted.

 Part of the collection of our associated tramway museum. Car has been partially restored to 1950's S.E.C. livery. Zebra striped and dash canopy lighting removed and front of car painted green. Operates under own power, using wandering lead. Last car to operate to Lydiard Street North on 19/9/71.

 Used as a shelter shed. Some equipment has been donated to the B.T.P.S. Trucks and other equipment went to our associted tramway museum in Perth. Last car to operate from Sebastopol to City then last car from City to Depot via Drummond Street North on 19/9/71.

 Car operated in Melbourne between 20th and 24/9/71 to promote
 Ballarat as part of Tourism Week.Car now stored at Preston
 Woekshops while negotiations continue to determine its future.
- South Pacific Electric Railway Co-Operative Society, Loftus NSW. 9/71. Part of the collection of our associated tramway museum. Car now stored at Enfield Roundhouse in Sydney pending negotiations on the future of the S.P.E.R. museum site at Loftus. Car sat at City Loop on last day but not used in regular service.

- Lions Club, Lismore. 10/71.
 On display at Lismore, near locomotive D3 619. Last car to operate to Mount Pleasant and ran last scheduled service to Gardens via Sturt Street West on 5/9/71. Also in last convoy to Sebastopol on 19/9/71.

 Stored at S.E.C depot, Ballarat. Last car to operate in service in Ballarat on 19/9/71. Operated last service from Sebastopol to Hospital Corner and then carried S.E.C Employees and guests to Depot.
 - River Promotion Committee, Horsham. 10/71.
 Stored under cover at Horsham. To be operated beside Wimmera River as a tourist attraction.
 - Zionist Congregational Church, Sebastopol. 10/71.
 Trucks donated by S.E.C. to West Aust. Electric Transport
 Museum. Body sold to church and subsequently re-built to
 a Sunday School. Located in Walker Street Sebastopol near
 Albert Street. Last car to operate from Lydiard Street North
 to City on 19/9/71.
 - Apex Club, Geelong. 10/71.
 On display in protective enclosure at Queens Park, Geelong.
 To be restored to former condition as Geelong No. 40. Car sat in City Loop on last day but not used in regular service.
