n the weekend of the 10th and 11th of October the B.T.P.S. Engineering Branch relaid short sections of the Endouree Pde. track in concrete. The aim of the exercise was to remove several kinks in the rails. A good deal of orginization went into this work to enable the tramway service to continue. This was the first time since tramway operations had commenced in Wendouree Pde. that track work had been carried out. The weekend produced another forst when on running out the first car on Saturday it was discovered that the tram tracks at the northern end of the line were flooded and that the che track was impassible. The service was terminated 200 metres short of the northern terminus for a period of some 3 hours until the water subsided.

service. Towards the end of yet another days work George Horse collapsed and died suddenly on September 28th. A replacement is being
sought.
