Dear Jack,
Thank you very much for your Christmas card & for the
batch of photos. They are lovely and to see what a real engine
is. I certainly like the N.S.W. D59 which looks like a
combination of V.R. N & S.A.R. 740 classes.

Very little steam is about and the only ^{steam} train passenger work
is the 7.10am to Maryborough mixed & its mate back in the afternoon,
plus 4.15pm Sat's only (mixed) I generally see the last named.
Recently A² 828 hauled the 4.15pm on two Saturdays. Tried for
a shot both times but weather was rotten. Actually, we have had
one fine weekend (mostly Fri & Sat's) since 1st Aug.

My health is no good, in fact I'm getting worse - the heart
doesn't get enough blood especially in cold weather. This afternoon
I had a job of painting my brother-in-law house and I happened
to look up over the Nth towards East Loco & blow me down if
there wasn't 3 jets of black smoke racing skywards. They were
on the 1.30pm to Geelong. He can't see the trains from this
part of York St but the smoke shows up alright. Last
3 steam hauled goods I saw was on 8/9/58. (See enclosed
print)

Regards the steam locos stored in Ballarat. At Loco
are the following N401, R701, 703 (stored) while D'565, R715,
716, 718, 763 are held for the shof's.

There are quite a few R^o at the Workshops, but I can't give

full list. However, here goes. № 11 crane loco & Y127 are the shunting pilots. K145 is in parts & I doubt if it will see service again. R713, 732, 749 are some of the ~~R~~ R class.

Yard pilots at Ballarat East Loco are = Y106, D'564, D²595, 600 D³626, 647. also K143 & 183 are often used on such work.
