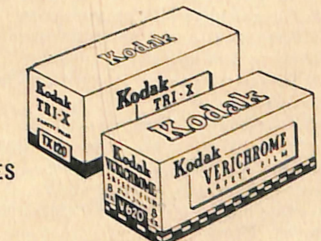

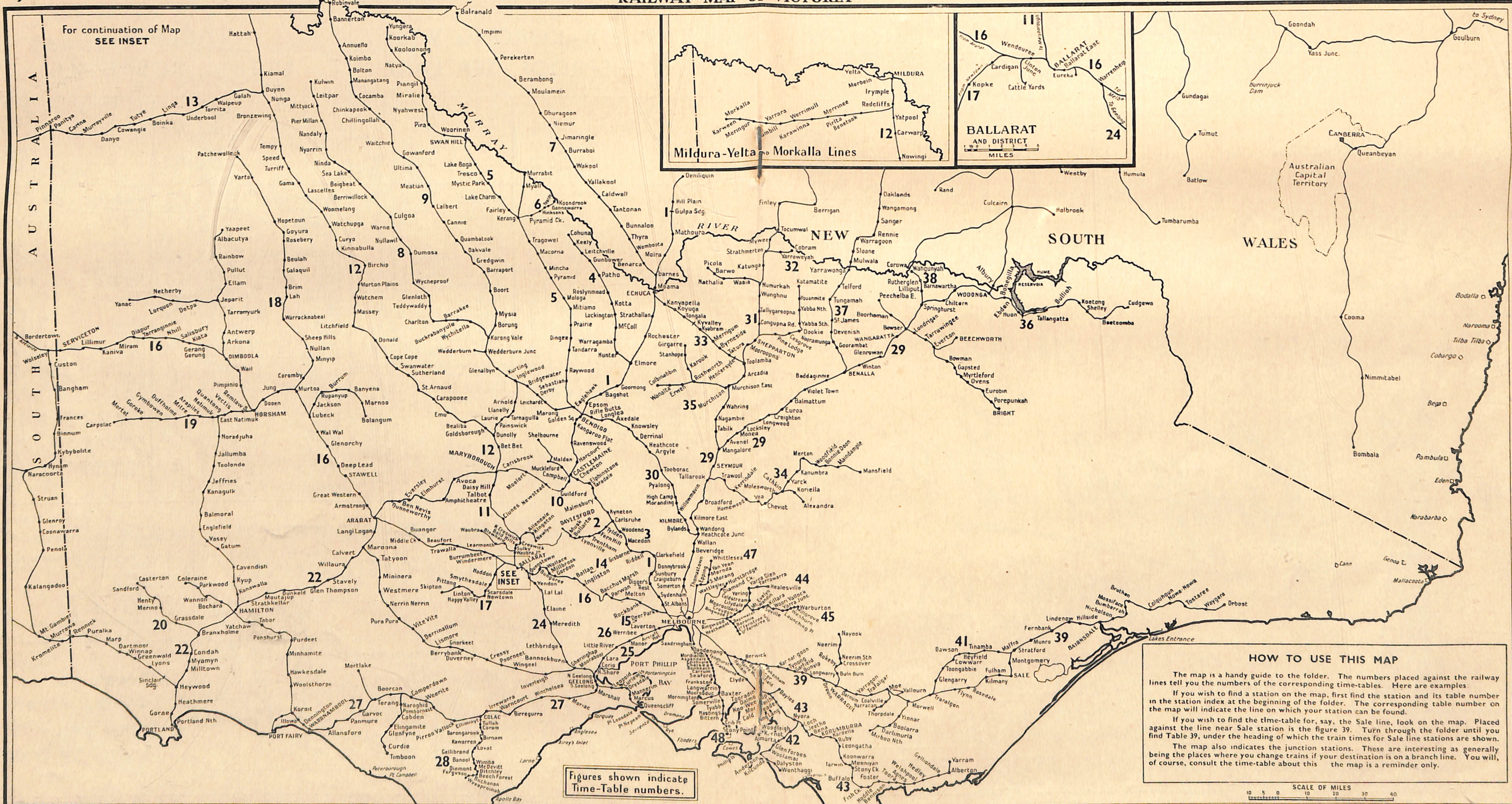

HOW TO USE THIS MAP

The map is a handy guide to the railway lines tell you the numbers of the corresponding time-tables. Here are examples:

If you wish to find a station on the map, first find the station and its table number in the station index at the beginning of the folder. The corresponding table number on the map will indicate the line on which your station can be found.

If you wish to find the time-table for, say, the Sale line, look on the map. Placed against the line near Sale station is the figure 39. Turn through the folder until you find Table 39, under the heading of which the train times for Sale line stations are shown.

The map also indicates the junction stations. These are interesting as generally being the places where you change trains if your destination is on a branch line. You will, of course, consult the time-table about this the map is a reminder only.
