This Spring, the concept of fast, high-frequency InterCity and InterUrban rail transport becomes fact.

There are up to 50% more train services running across the State.

And they're running faster.

For example, on the new InterCity services, Warrnambool is now 37 minutes closer to Melbourne. With 50% more services each weekday. Albury is now 45 minutes closer, with 12 more services a week.

On the InterUrban services, Geelong has 30 more trains each way per week; places like Kyneton and Seymour now have 18 more trains each way a week. And Traralgon actually has twice as many as before.

In short, every major centre is now linked by a fast, high-frequency transport system more advanced in concept than any other passenger service in Australia.

Trains that carry you in comfort and safety at speeds well in excess of the State's maximum open road speed limit.

And we are introducing the first of the new open, saloon-style carriages with panoramic windows, luxurious woollen-fabric seating and deep-pile carpets. There will also be extended catering facilities on InterCity services.

In all, over \$50 million is being spent establishing standards of equipment and services beyond anything seen previously in this State.

On top of that, we've just introduced the first State-wide computer-based reservation and call-handling facilities for any Australian rail system.

Just ring your nearest regional booking centre (listed pages 6 & 7) for immediate seat reservations and confirmations on any InterCity services. These centres can also handle your InterState travel requirements.

In addition we now have many authorised travel and ticket agencies across the State. With these and our station network you can now make reservations, enquiries, purchase and collect tickets almost whenever and wherever you want.

And that's only the beginning.

You can also make connections with co-ordinated coach services around the State that link even more areas with the central rail system.

As well as making easy connections with domestic and international flights from Tullamarine via mini-buses that depart Spencer and Flinders Street Stations every half hour.

It's a faster, more efficient and streamlined service than Victorians have ever enjoyed.

And it's the start of a program that will meet our travel needs well into the 1990s and beyond.

The New Services.

InterUrban

That's the name of our new high frequency commuter services to and from Bacchus Marsh, Ballarat, Geelong, South Geelong, Kyneton, Seymour, Traralgon and Warragul.

These are short-distance journeys, and seat reservations are not required on services originating or terminating at these stations.

InterCity.

These are new, faster, longer distance services to and from Albury, Bairnsdale, Bendigo, Dimboola, Horsham, Mildura, Numurkah, Sale, Shepparton, Swan Hill and Warrnambool.

Seat reservations are required for all InterCity services. The timetables indicate this for you with a symbol.

There is one exception. You *do not* have to book on services that *originate* or *terminate* in Bendigo.

Of course, the booking service is immediate and absolutely free.

The InterCity service is complemented by an extensive coach network that links over 100 other country centres with the rail services.

InterState.

InterState services are also now on the computer-based, call handling system, and you can make reservations anytime between 5.45am and 10pm any day of the year.

How to use the new booking service.

The following pages show in green which regional centres have direct, on-line computer reservation facilities.

Ring your closest booking centre for immediate bookings and confirmation, and to arrange when and where you'd like to pick-up and pay for your tickets.

Calls can be made between 5.45am and 10pm every day of the year.

Of course, reservations can also be made through any other VicRail stations or authorised VicRail ticket or travel agents, in which case your bookings will be phoned through to the reservations centre and your seat confirmed.

You can collect your tickets at most stations or the VicRail agent of your choice.


Most reservations can be made up to 2 months in advance on InterCity services, and up to 12 months in advance on InterState services. However, limited advance reservations apply to shorter journeys on some InterCity services. The () symbol in the timetable shows where this is applicable.

Passengers travelling without a ticket are liable to a fine of up to \$100.

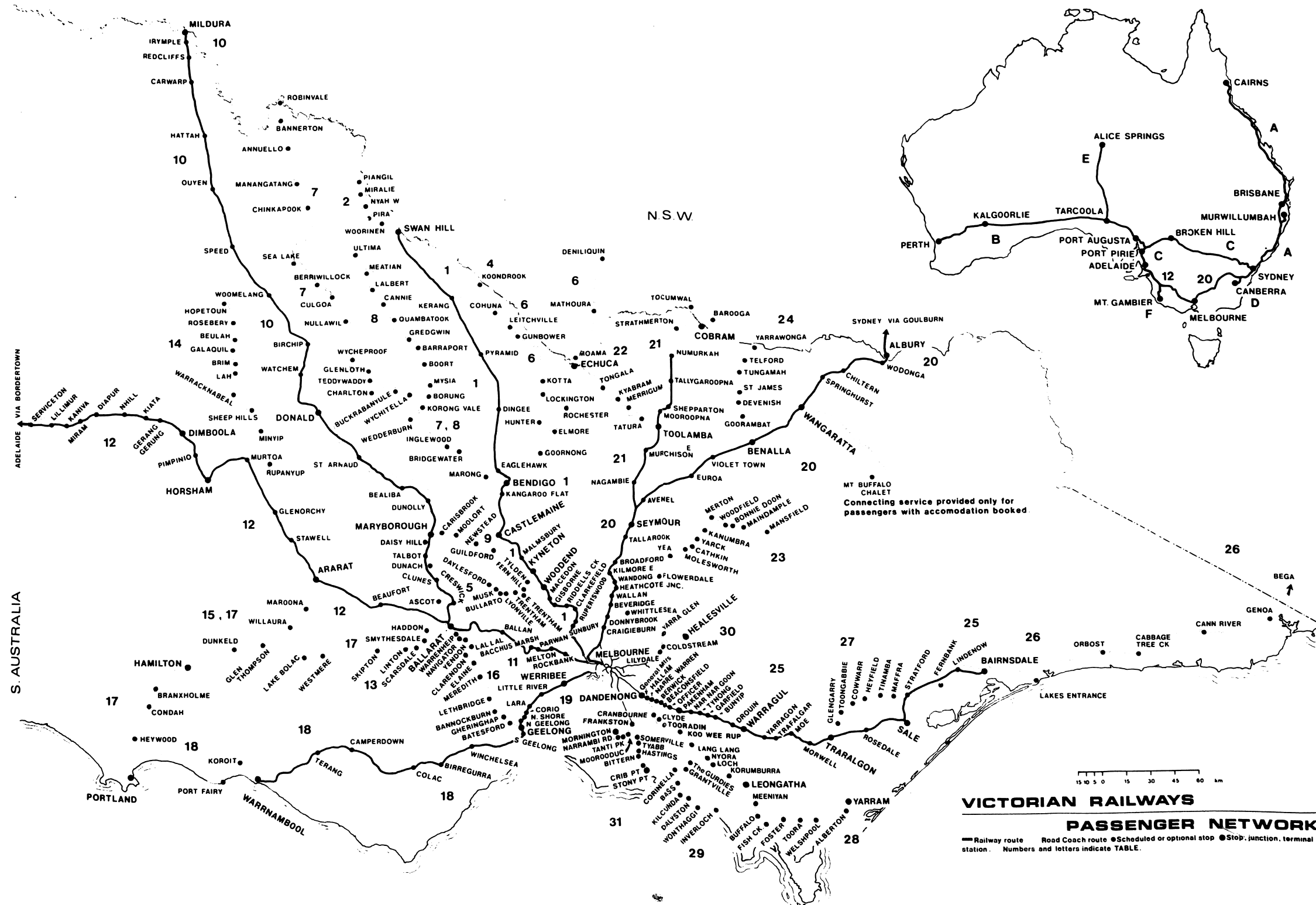
