STURT STAKES OR DIVISION—17 yards.

ALBERT STAKES—16 yards.

ASCOT STAKES—15 yards.

Winner of Sturt, Albert or Ascot Stake—Penalty, 1 yard.

Two (2) Losing Runs in Albert or Ascot Stake—Handicap increases One (1) yard.

Park Handicap—14 yards.

Winner penalised 1 yard, and must run two (2) losing runs to go up 1 yard. On reaching 11 yards mark only one (1) losing run to go up 1 yard.

Any dog off 15 yards winning Park Handicap, penalty One (1) yard. Heats and Finals—Maiden—Winner's mark 17 yards. Winner of heat, penalised 1 yard; Winner of Final, penalised 1 yard; Winner of Heat and Final, penalised 2 yards.

HURDLES.—Trial Hurdles (For dogs who have never won a Hurdle Race and Limit dogs of Handicap Hurdle)—Winner penalised 1 yards.

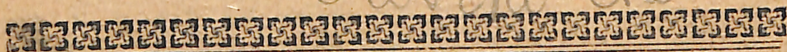
